(i) Methods to upload personal images/video on the Canvia device

1. Canvia Member Website(my.canvia.art)

- a. Advantage: Multi file upload, Ability to create personal playlist, Video upload, Google photos support, NFT support etc.
- b. Disadvantage: Uploading Mobile/ipad images will require you to upload on my.canvia.art via "My Uploads" on the mobile web browser

2. Canvia Mobile App

- a. Advantage: Uploaded images don't go to cloud(If you are particular about privacy)
- b. Disadvantage: Multi-file upload not allowed, playlist creation not possible, Thumbnails don't appear in the queue, No video upload support

3. Canvia Desktop App

a. Advantage: Multi-file upload, Ability to create a personal playlist, Write a description of the playlist or artworks, Create categories of playlists, Ability to add multiple images to the playlist using a single click, Video upload etc.


b. Disadvantage: Uploading Mobile/ipad images will require you to upload on my.canvia.art via "My Uploads" on the mobile web browser

(ii) Steps to display your personal images on the Canvia device


- 1. Upload all your images on Canvia web account (my.canvia.art)
- 2. Create (or edit) playlists using uploaded images
- 3. Play playlists using either (a)Mobile app-> Personal Playlist (b) Use queue mechanism to play using either of these two commands "Play" or "Add to queue"

(iii) Uploads images to Canvia web account:

(a) On "My Collection" page, at the bottom of the page, click on "New Upload" as shown below.




(b) Upload files as shown below from your computer.




(iv) Create(edit) playlists using uploaded images

(a) Below any uploaded image, you will find six options. 4th option will allow you to add to a playlist a shown below.




(b) Once you click on that option, you can either add the image to one existing playlist or create a new playlist as shown below.



(v) Play Playlists(Mobile App or Website)

Two ways to play your personal playlist

- (i) Canvia mobile app->Personal Playlist->select the appropriate playlist and select any image to display on Canvia device.
- (ii) "Play" or "Add to Queue" for pushing the selected playlist to the Canvia queue as shown below

You can check the playlist in the queue sequence after clicking on the queue icon as shown below:

(vii) Video support(Looping, Orientation and Fullscreen)

- (a) Video Type support: mp4(GIF is not supported, currently)
- (b) Video Loop support

By Default, video is in loop mode: If Queue playback is OFF, then Video keeps playing in loop. There are two cases possible if Queue playback is ON:

Case 1:

If Queue playback time period > Total video play time, video will keep on playing in loop till the queue playback time is over

Case 2:

If Queue playback time period < Total video playtime, video will keep on playing till the queue playback time is over and move to the next video/image in the queue after that.

(c) Video Orientation

Both vertical(portrait) and Horizontal (Landscape) modes are supported. You can change the settings as you do for images.

(d) Video Fullscreen mode

Video runs in full-screen mode if the display mode is "pan n scan" mode

(e) Video File Size limit


Video file size at best should be 100MB. For more than 75MB, expect some buffering delay so "Play" after full download.

(f) Video upload methods


Video can only be uploaded from the website(my.canvia.art) or desktop app. Mobile app currently does not support video upload.

(viii) Google Photos(Steps to connect)

(a) On "My Collection" page, at the bottom of the page, click on "CONNECT TO GOOGLE PHOTOS" as shown below.





(ix) Google Photos(Steps to Disconnect)



(x) NFT(Connect with Wallet)

(a) On "NFT" page, click on icon and provide your wallet credentials as shown below:



(b) You will see the thumbnail of the NFTs on Canvia as shown below with a "play" option.
